The Gala of Laureates of the Republican Contest of Plastic Arts and Crafts “The World Through the Eyes of Children”, 12th edition, entitled “Ion Druta’s Work”, organized by the Republican Center for Children and Youth “ARTICO” took place today, 17 May, in Chisinau. The event aimed at promoting young talents by stimulating individuality in creation and plastic expression.

In the context of supporting and stimulating ideas of creativity, art and innovation, the State Agency on Intellectual Property (AGEPI) participated as a partner of the contest. 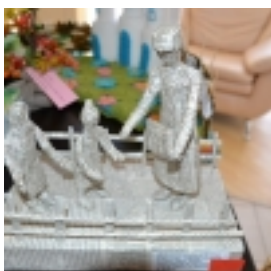
