The IP workshop **“The Role of New Technologies in Consolidating the Institutional Capacities of the IP Offices: Digital Transformation”** took place on September 9, in Chisinau. The workshop took place in a hybrid format and was organized by AGEPI with the support of the EU project “Support for Structured Policy Dialogue, Coordination of the Implementation of the Association Agreement and Enhancement of the Legal Approximation Process” for the Republic of Moldova, in cooperation with the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO), the European Patent Office (EPO) and the European Union Intellectual Property Office (EUIPO).

In the opening, the Director General of AGEPI, Eugeniu Rusu, expressed his certainty that the workshop will become a communication platform, in which everyone will be able to share the experience related to new technologies: implementation, challenges and successes.

Roundtable: Legal Framework, Gaps and Ongoing Developments; Human Capital and Digital Literacy.

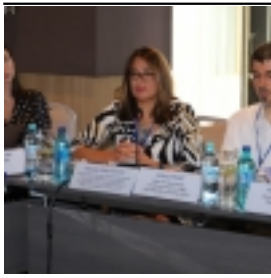
