The State Agency on Intellectual Property (AGEPI) launched a special training course in the field of intellectual property, aimed at consolidating knowledge and developing skills for the provision of qualified services for the protection and enforcement of intellectual property rights.

The program includes theoretical and practical sessions on the main intellectual property objects, including inventions, plant varieties, trademarks, geographical indications, industrial designs, copyright and related rights, as well as the economics and valuation of intellectual property.

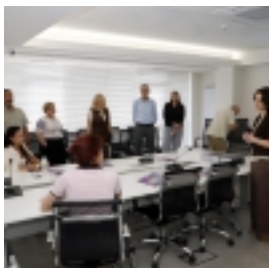
The trainings are supported by specialists from AGEPI, who will share with the participants their knowledge and practical experience in the field.

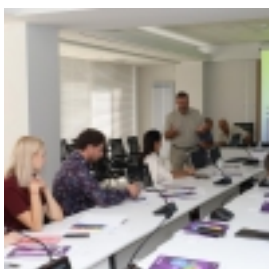

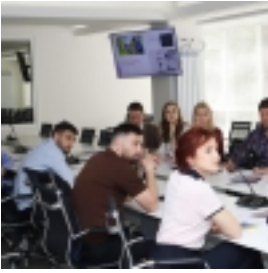
